- 3. Merge onto QEW toward NIAGARA. go 1.2 km
- 4. Take the HWY-405 exit, EXIT 37, on the LEFT toward QUEENSTON/LEWISTON U.S.A.. go 0.4 km
- 5. Merge onto PROVINCIAL ROUTE 405 E. go 4.7 km
- 6. Take the RR-102/STANLEY AVENUE exit toward NIAGARA FALLS/NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE. *go 0.4 km*
- 7. Take the ramp toward NIAGARA PKWY./NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE. *go 0.10 km*
- 8. Turn LEFT onto RR-102 / STANLEY AVE. go 0.1 km
- 9. Turn RIGHT onto PORTAGE RD. go 3.3 km
- 10. Enter next roundabout and take the 3rd exit.


